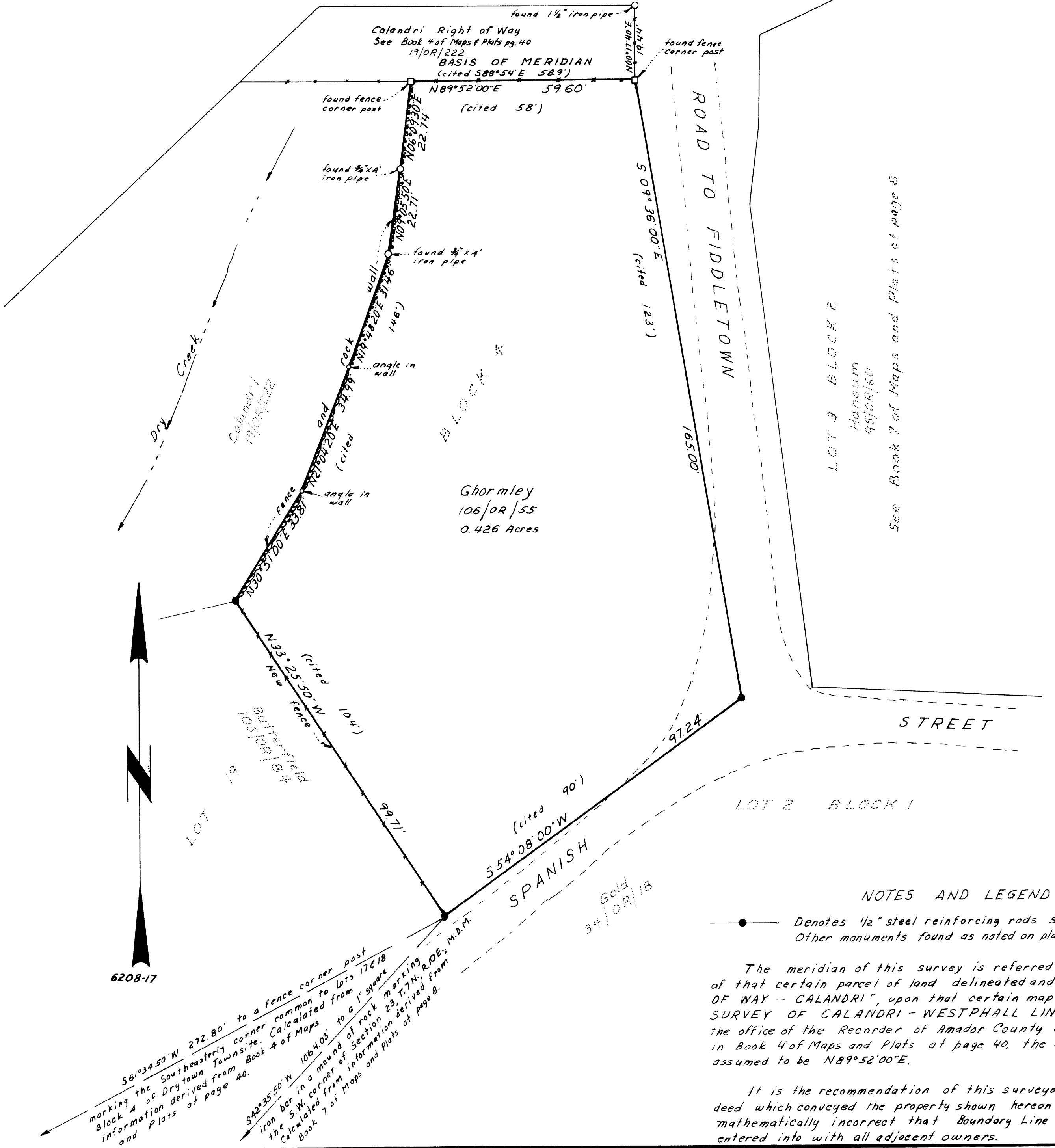


RECORD OF SURVEY

The meridian of this survey is referred to the South line of that certain parcel of land delineated and designated "RT. OF WAY - CALANDRI", upon that certain map entitled "PLAT OF SURVEY OF CALANDRI - WESTPHALL LINES", recorded in the office of the Recorder of Amador County on March 3, 1948, in Book 4 of Maps and Plats at page 40, the bearing of which is assumed to be N89°52'00"E.

It is the recommendation of this surveyor that since the deed which conveyed the property shown hereon is vague and mathematically incorrect that Boundary Line Agreements be entered into with all adjacent owners.
