S 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W 8.88 ch, S 85 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° W 9.23 ch, N 68 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W 4.51 ch, S 79 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W 2.80 ch,
S 56 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° W 8.33 ch, S 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W 7.14 ch, to quarter Section line Run
S 33° E 10.66 ch, to United States Meander line Run North 78° E 30.92 ch,
S 61° E 11 ch to the place of beginning. The above was surveyed
